WHO DROVE LITTLEBITS IMPLEMENTATION?

Tim Hammill is a supervisor who coordinates educational technology and curricula in Westmoreland County, PA.





WHERE WAS LITTLEBITS USED?

Professional development workshops for teachers in Westmoreland County's 17 school districts.



WHAT WAS THE GOAL OF THE EFFORT?

- Encourage project-based teaching where educators facilitate and guide learning
- Get teachers to jump into STEM-related activities even if they've previously been reluctant to teach technology.



WHY LITTLEBITS?
